Please see the below for an update on the floods that occurred in the City of Butler on 7/5/2017 and 7/6/2017:

All residents should contact 211 for assistance including families, especially with young children experiencing high anxiety and / or emotional distress.

Anyone wishing to contribute monetary donations can also dial 211 for a list of organizations.

Currently the American Red Cross is stationed at the Butler City Fire Department, 110 N. Washington St. Butler, PA 16001, and they are handing out clean up kits to residents.

There is a shelter opened and staffed by American Red Cross at:

First United Methodist Church at 200 E. North Street will be collecting cleaning supplies, garbage bags and personal hygiene products until 8 pm tonight.

Starting Friday, July 7<sup>th</sup> for affected city residents in the flooded area; dumpsters will be located at the following locations:

- West Diamond Street by swinging bridge
- Hayes Avenue by Shiloh Baptist Church
- Battery Warehouse parking lot
- Miller Avenue at the entrance to Memorial Park
- Broad Street Elementary School main entrance
